1	Will we be able to charge the university the additional costs associated with these products. Or do events still have to stay within the states allowed per diem? ( <i>Note: Question is specifically related to catering services.</i> )	Per diem rates, which are regulated at the federal level, have not been impacted by EO77. Further, catering is not subject to per diem rates when the purchase of catering services is made through a purchase order and not classified as a business expense.
2	Does this apply to single-use laboratory supplies?	Single-use laboratory supplies are exempt from EO77. However, we strongly encourage vendors to work with UVA because these materials are included in UVA's sustainability goals – including a goal to reduce our waste footprint 70% below 2020 amounts by 2030.
